SITUATION

In Movado's legacy ERP system, a user could start out with incomplete or incorrect data and fix it along the way. SAP* requires complete accuracy with master data from the beginning. These exacting standards were a whole new world for Movado. A world that would change the way the company handles their new internal business processes.

So, a critical part of this transition for Dr. Frank Morelli, SVP Global Business Process & CIO of Movado, was the management of the company's data.

Documentation while managing the data through this change was also a priority. Movado would be under tremendous scrutiny because of the scope and reach of the implementation. It was imperative that documented evidence of control checks be available. The requirements for documentation of specifications, transports, change management, testing and validations were above and beyond anything you could imagine. Morelli explains, "There were valid concerns about moving an entire company's worth of data all at once, worldwide, changing every major business process and running the company on all new software. We were moving fast and the documentation was important."

Understanding that preparation before go-live and execution of maintenance afterwards could take away much of the unnecessary challenges with the upcoming move to the new ERP system, Frank was looking for a solution.

SOLUTION

Movado was prepared. Through the use of ERP^{2™}, they were able to overcome many of the hurdles associated with the migration and management of SAP data. They did a tremendous amount of testing and had a successful go-live right from the start. They were able to successfully complete all of their business activities: take and fill orders, ship product and collect revenue — the whole 9 yards. The efforts of all the MGI employees were recognized by Movado's inclusion in the 2009 Information Week 500. Much of the success with master data can be attributed to their employee's use of Quadrate's data loading software, ERP².

Almost a year later, the software continues to be the go-to solution for uploading data. Users with no technical skills can use ERP² to securely transfer data into SAP. Being able to use Microsoft products without loss of data integrity made the software very appealing. "The Quadrate users are loading their own data. Excel is something they use every day and they are all happy" explained Ravi Karingula, Movado's GIT Developer. Knowing all the SAP validations are performed and there is no way to go around the users security settings, gives the IT group a feeling of confidence with the solution.


ERP² avoids dependency on Developers:

Making every hour count before go-live.

ERP^{2™} saved weeks:

To ensure the automated picking system could handle the volumes of orders being created in SAP*, multiple test orders had to be created to simulate real life transactions. Heavy volume and stress testing was made possible with ERP². It was used to generate orders which had multiple lines and all kinds of variations. The deliveries were blasted from SAP down through the automated picking system. Without Quadrate, we would have spent many weeks creating test data. "If we would have had to enter the test data into our picking system manually, we would have gone out of our minds" said Morelli.

ERP² saved 84 days:

The law requires a 7-year history for inactive employees to remain on file. There were 8,000 inactive employees to load into SAP after go-live. Each one would have taken 3-5 minutes...about 670 noninterrupted hours. With ERP² the entire process only took one day.

Many hours were saved on initial data loads with the use of ERP2:

"ERP² shortened implementation and development time" said Richard Higgins, Director of Global Information Technology Business Solutions. Morelli added that, "The developers avoided a significant programming workload along with the documentation involved in developing any program. It took a tremendous burden off our initial data loads. With ERP², problems were clear and easy to identify and correct." The intuitive debugging feature, unique to Quadrate, is extremely helpful. When error messages from SAP are unclear, the screen by screen step-through quickly identifies the source of the error so corrections can be made immediately.

With ERP² a correction was done in minutes instead of days:

Because Movado is a multi branded company, the set up of the Partner Function in SAP was very complicated. A master data mistake was uncovered in testing, affecting one of their largest customers with almost 1,500 locations. The impact of the incorrect data could have been potentially disastrous and taken days to recover from without the use of ERP². Movado was able to use

ERP² to correct the data in minutes, preventing a landslide of customer issues after go-live.

Making every hour count after go-live.

ERP² automates daily maintenance without programming:

In daily activities, ERP² is used to setup and maintain prices, discounts and promotions as well as create and maintain material master data. The users have seen the many different applications of ERP² and are spreading the cost and time savings into other departments by creating new ERP² templates to eliminate their current manual processes. Ovidio Cavallari is responsible for Movado's MDM globally. He stated "The most critical part of the MDM activities is related to the price master data." With ERP², uploading 100,000s of records for retail prices, discounts and promotions into SAP could be done without programming. Doing these activities manually would have caused a considerable bottleneck due to volume and the necessity to do the changes quickly.

ERP² continues to save hundreds of hours:

The apparel and footwear solution (AFS) is an SAP industry solution that structures data by dimensionalizing SKUs with extra details. Knowing where information is nested can be difficult to figure out, but Quadrate made it easy. Business users don't need to get involved with logging onto maintenance screens in SAP. The developer just builds a template and hands it off to the business users in an Excel format.
